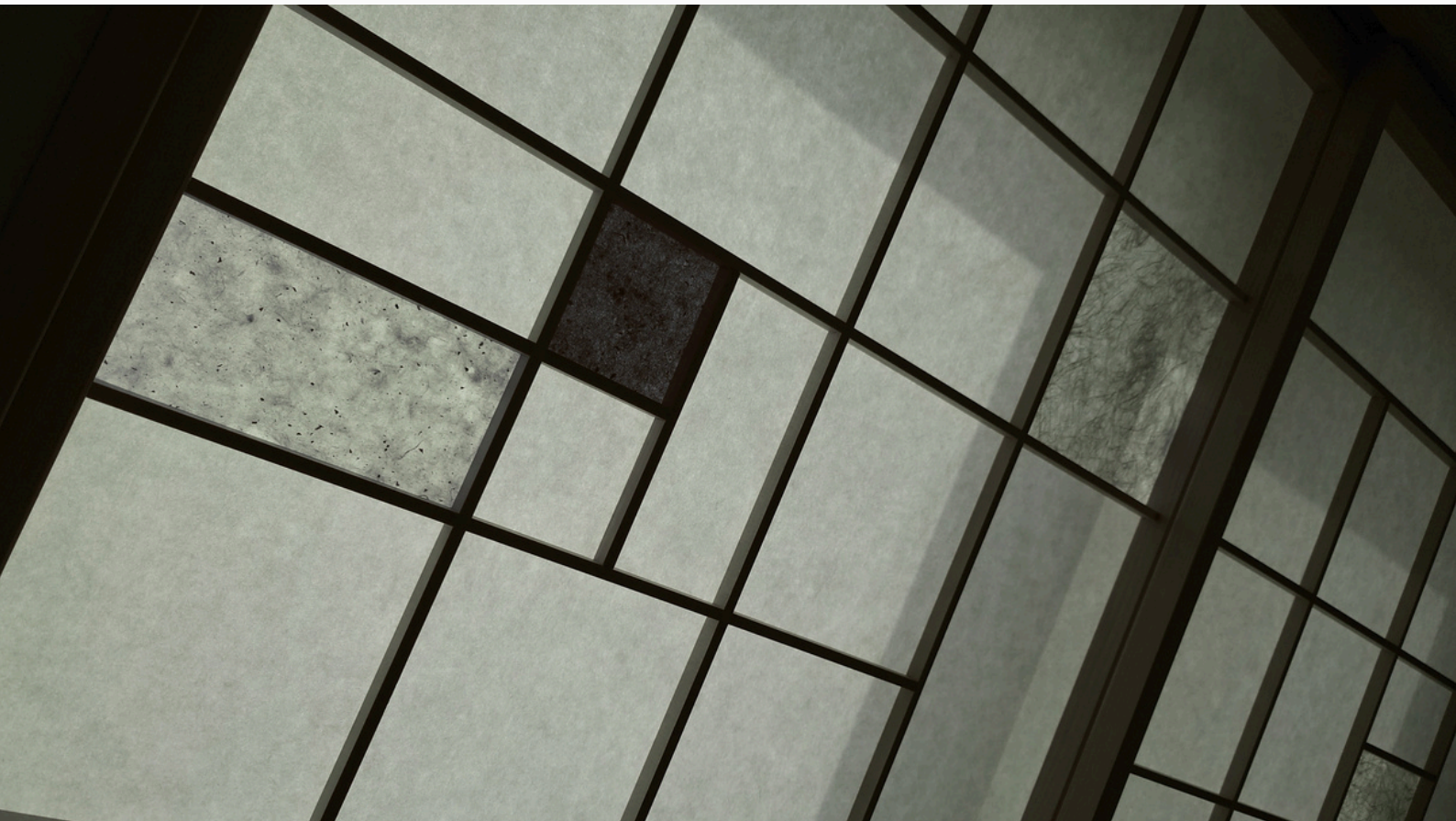

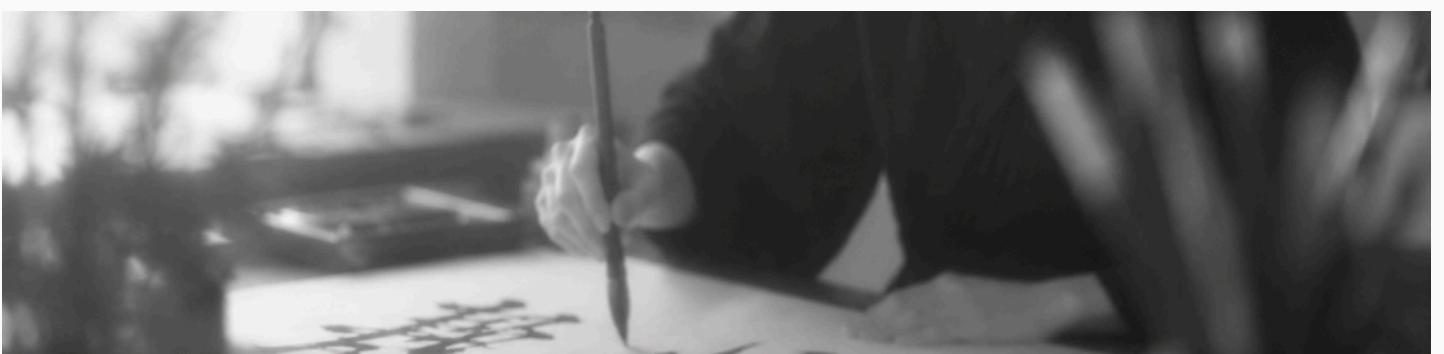


An art form unique to Japan and unlike anything else in the world — works created through the delicate expression of brush, ink, and paper, such as Japanese calligraphy and Nihonga painting.

Using only simple materials — ink, mineral pigments, brushes, and paper or silk — artists devote countless hours in pursuit of beauty, balance, and expression.

The technique of transforming these works into forms that can be beautifully displayed — such as hanging scrolls, folding screens, and framed pieces — is known as Hyogu.

To connect artwork, space, and aesthetic sensibility, hyogu craftsmen carefully consider materials, colors, and composition, crafting each piece by hand with meticulous attention to detail.

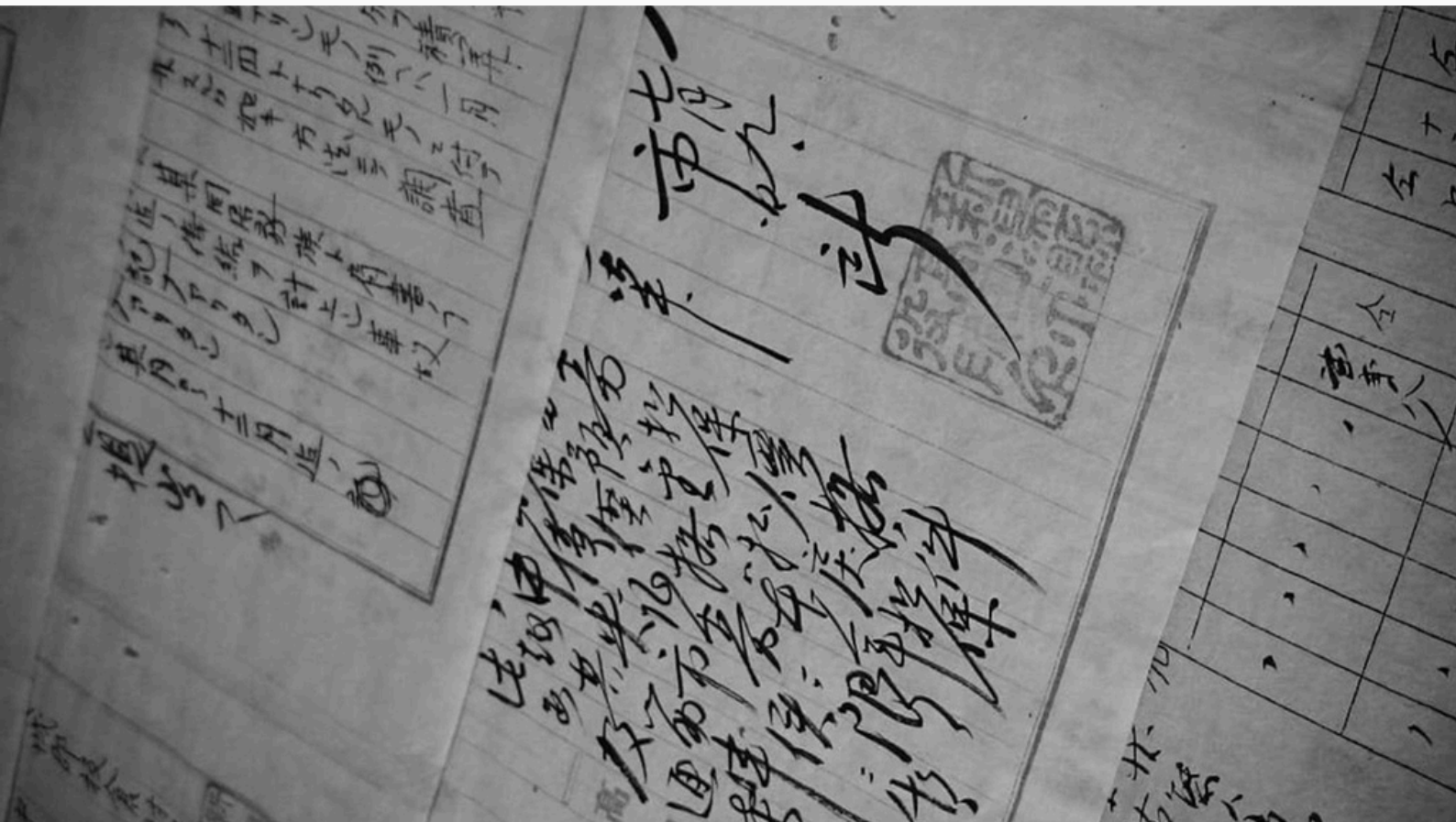
With a few exceptions, the products featured in this catalog are made-to-order.

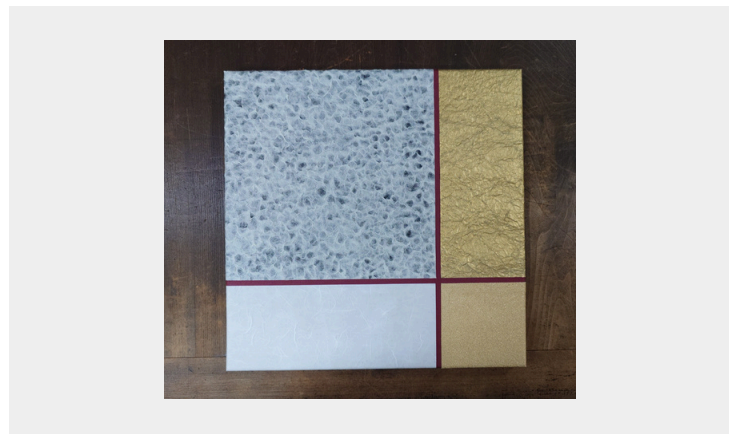


Washi Panel (和紙パネル)
